

This is a continuation of the memory booklet that you received at our kick-off brunch. Please enjoy the following memory and consider submitting a memory from your family as well!

Gus Mancy - Submitted by Ranee Wood and Aretta (Terri) Checkles

Our father was very proud of his Greek heritage after leaving his home in the village of Avthou on the island of Crete in 1914. He was 16 years old and had been running his family's coffee house in Crete since he was 13 years old. His family pooled their money together so he could have the chance to come to America where they had heard "the streets were paved of gold". On the way to America, he was told by a fortuneteller in NYC that he would live a long and successful life and have five children. This is exactly what happened!

He was not afraid of long hours of hard work and opened the Ideal Restaurant, later called Mancy's, in 1921 with his cousin, Nick Graham. The first Greek he met in Toledo was an owner of a downtown candy shop, Argerios Kostopoulos, our future grandfather. When he arrived in Toledo, our father had 2 names written on a paper for him to contact to find work: Gus Tzanakis and Jim Romanakis. Argerios introduced him to them and he started working at their restaurant on St. Clair Street. Argerios was one of the founders of our church. He had a daughter, Margaret, whom he married years later in 1934.

Everyone who has ever known him remembers him as a kind gentleman with a loving heart. When he was asked what was his best accomplishment in life, he would say that it was his family. "I was fortunate because even though I never finished school, all of my children were educated and successful."

He died at the age of 90 years in 1988 and was still going to his restaurant every day enjoying the compliments that he heard about the great food that was served. He was a charter member of AHEPA and very proud to be a life-long member of our beloved Holy Trinity Cathedral.

2014 Summer Monthly Luncheons by Dr. G. J. Biernacki

The Summer monthly Luncheons were a complete success. The luncheon team, consisting of 25 members of the Church, works like a well-oiled machine. I thank all of the volunteers for their time and effort in working on the luncheons for the past seven years. Also, I thank the numerous underwriters who donated money to defray some of the luncheon expenses.

Also, our guests have commented on the friendliness of our workers and their willingness to give information about our Cathedral and the Orthodox religion. Our activities show that the Cathedral is a jewel in the downtown area. The luncheons also give a tremendous lead-in to the festival in September. Job well done everyone! Looking forward to Summer 2015.
