

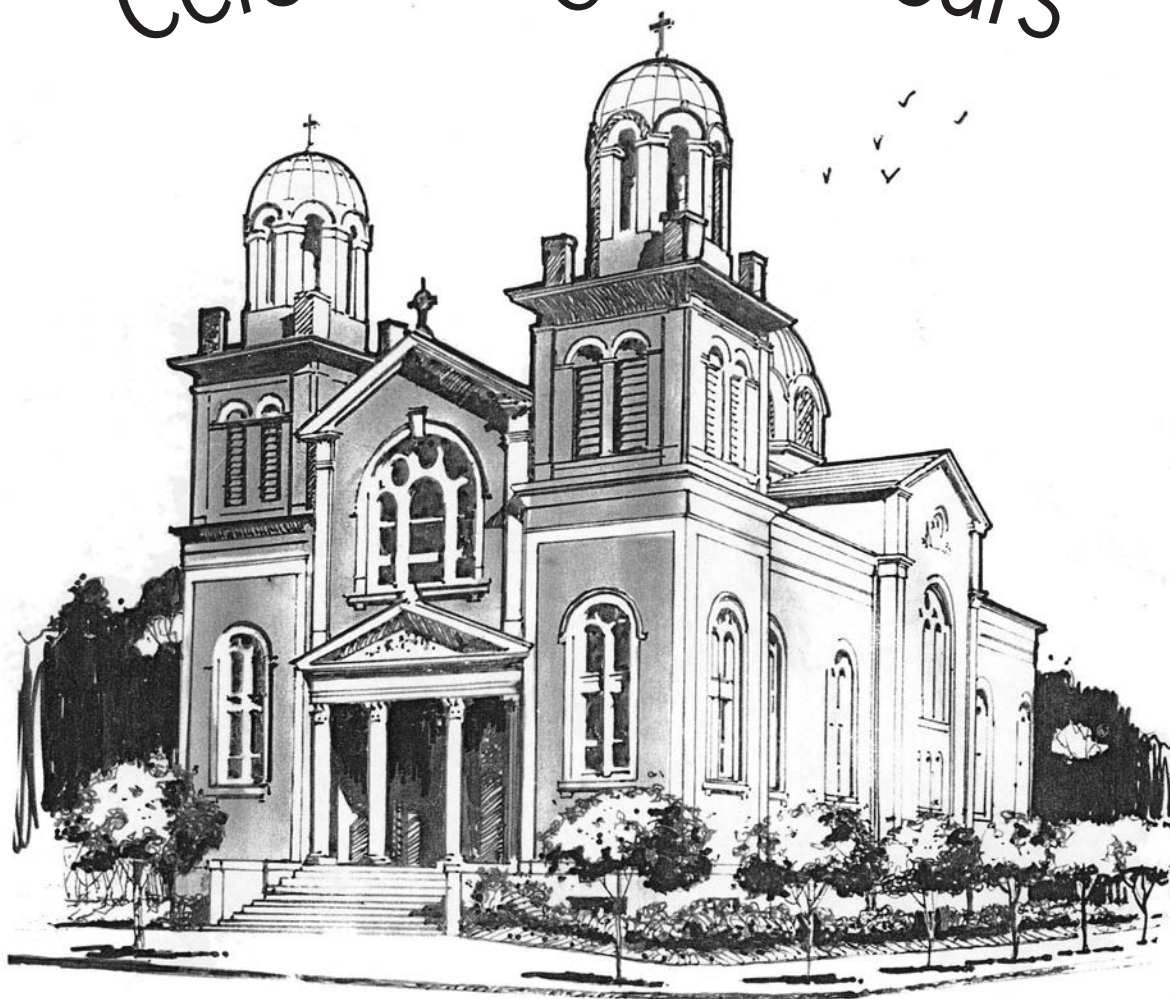

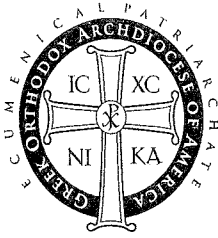

Dear Parish Family and Friends,

Christ is Risen!

Some of the fondest memories I have are from my time in Boston at our seminary. If you have ever visited the city you know that it is full of great places to see. One of the things I loved seeing were the reenactments of events in the history of our country. Those that were reenacting these events literally pulled you in and made you feel as if you were back in the time of the historical event. They would talk to you or yell at you and at times push you out of the way. I mention these memories because as Christians when we remember the events in the life of Christ and the Church we too participate in them in a real way. Sometimes we actually reenact these events like during Holy Week. Throughout Holy Week we bore witness to the events that led up to the death and resurrection of Christ. This month we will participate in the Ascension of our Lord and next month we will participate in the descent of the Holy Spirit during Pentecost. We must be careful that we are not merely "spectators" to these feasts. We must be careful that we are not just watching. But instead we must become changed.

Each of these feasts must elicit a change within us. Our Lord, on the glorious day of His resurrection, is once again calling us to receive Him as light in order to enlighten our current situation. On the day of our Lord's ascension into heaven we are given the opportunity to ascend with Him. One author says, "Christ our Lord ascends so that we may ascend with him. What is the Liturgy, what is prayer, but the constant ascension of man into the presence of God?" Will we remember to grow ever closer to our Lord through prayer? On the great day of Pentecost we are once again receiving the Holy Spirit. St Cyril of Jerusalem tells us that the Spirit "adapts itself to the nature and need of every creature". Will we be willing to allow the Holy Spirit to offer to us that which we need?

As we continue to enter into these great feasts I pray we remember to not merely be "spectators" but to be changed by them. I pray that we as a community allow the Lord to help us grow as individual members in the body of Christ in order to grow closer to one another in unity.

***Community Cookbook by Jeanne Gatoura***

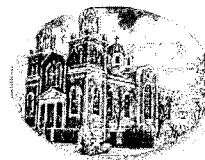
May is the month of holidays, observances, graduations, and warming weather - all perfect excuses for parties. Whether you're hosting the event or attending a potluck and you're stuck deciding what to prepare, look to *Olives, Feta, Phyllo & More*, the encyclopedia of party fare! And if you're having difficulty deciding from the cookbook's plethora of appetizers, dishes, and desserts, let the Suggested Menus section be your guide.

For instance from "Party at the Plaka", Karen George's Tomato & Olive Tart makes a beautiful presentation which she finds ideal for a party. To create this deliciously layered creation, first diced Kalamata olives, shallot, dried thyme, dried basil, and olive oil are combined in a small bowl, then seasoned to taste with salt and pepper. On a small cookie sheet, 10 to 12 individually buttered phyllo sheets are layered. The phyllo edges should be rolled to create a rimmed edge. Sliced plum tomatoes are first arranged on the phyllo and sprinkled with the Kalamata mixture. Using a fork, Karen spreads the mixture evenly over the top and bakes in a preheated 400 degree oven until the edges are brown. Another layer of flavor and color is added with a sprinkling of shredded mozzarella cheese and another five minutes of baking. The tart is cut into 12 squares, then each piece diagonally, thus creating 12 to 18 servings.

Another selection, Maria Kopan's Chocolate Chip Marble Cookies are a family favorite and a hit when taken to an event. To begin, the cake mix package from a Duncan Hines marble cake mix box, an egg, canola oil and water are mixed together well. Semi-sweet chocolate chips are stirred in. In a separate bowl, 2 tablespoons batter, the chocolate packet contents from the box and water are stirred together. Marbling is then done by stirring or kneading basic cookie dough with the marble batter until the desired effect is achieved. With the aid of an ice cream scoop, cookie dough is dropped onto an ungreased cookie sheet and baked for 12 minutes in a preheated 350 degree oven. Maria added that this recipe which makes 36 cookies, doubles and triples well and is easy baking with the children.

### ***HOLY TRINITY HISTORY FROM THE TOLEDO BLADE***

#### **ASK POLICE AID**

**From the Toledo News Bee, April 15, 1922**

**“Greeks Fear Church Will Be Blown Up”**

Two Greek factions are said to be at war in Toledo. Police have been asked to prevent trouble at the services to be held in the Hellenic Orthodox Church, Walnut and Superior streets, on Saturday night. Threats to blow up the church have been made, it is said.

At least two police officers will be assigned to the job of preventing Greek from clashing with Greek when the congregation gathers in the candle lighted edifice for Easter worship.

#### **ANCIENT FEUD**

The feud has been of long standing, according to members of the Hellenic congregation, on Saturday. There are about 10 to 15 members of the faction, which swears allegiance to the King of Greece and wants, so the other side says, to bring politics into the church,

Those opposed to the King call themselves Democrats and are greatly in the majority in Toledo, it is reported.

We came to America to be free and we don't like the King; we want to keep politics out of the church – religion and politics should not be mixed, Steve Kakmis, Greek Democrat, said on Saturday morning.

#### **CHARGES THREATS**

“There have been threats to blow up our church and to shoot. We don't want any disturbance and we just called police to be sure there wouldn't be any trouble.”

The feud between the Royalists and Democrats threatened to flame up the other night at the White Eagle Restaurant on Cherry St. One of the members of the Royalist's faction flourished a pistol at the Democrat cook in the place, it is said. No shots were fired and the matter is to be aired in Police Court.

In the new Hellenic Church, on Saturday, women and children cast furtive glances about as they purchased

tapers and placed them in receptacles to show their representation in the worship.

James Petros, restaurateur, Huron and Adams Streets, said on Saturday, in speaking for the faction that opposes those remaining in the church, that the fears, of the Greek Democrats are unwarranted.

Petros said a much larger number than the "Democrats" say have withdrawn and formed a new congregation known as St George Greek Church.

"The difference here in Toledo goes back to old world disputes," Petros said. "We who dropped out believe the Patriarch was elected without fair representation of all elements in the church. Those who remain in the Hellenic Church stand by the Patriarch.

There is nothing to fear. We are abiding as any citizens and we disagree with the other fraction quietly and orderly."

("Mr. Steve Kakmis stood on the church steps and said, "We will name our Church Holy Trinity.")

### **Guard Church Nov. 8, 1923 - The Toledo Blade Greek Orthodox Changes Priests; Trouble Feared**

Police and detectives stood in the rear of the Greek Orthodox Church, Superior and Walnut Streets, on Thursday morning, while St James' Day services were being conducted by Rev. A. Mandelaris of Chicago, newly installed priest. Officers were called to the church to avert trouble that was said to have been threatened by a faction of the church which is opposing the installation of the new priest to succeed the Rev. Emanuel Papastefanou.

### **Congregation Restless**

The dissenting faction left the church before the start of the services, returned in the middle of the services, and then quickly went out again. The former priest did not appear at the church during the morning.

Groups gathered early in the morning and excitedly discussed their differences, but there was no disorder and no reason for police to interfere.

### **Guards Are Posted**

Guards were posted about the church on Wednesday night and the doors were said to have been barred against the Rev. Mr. Papastefanou, who appeared outside with several supporters. Police who were present during the night also, maintained quiet about the church.

Fearing a serious disturbance, only a few women were in the church on Thursday morning. The board of trustees of the church, in electing a new priest, is endeavoring to establish an independent Greek church until social conditions are bettered in Greece, it was said.

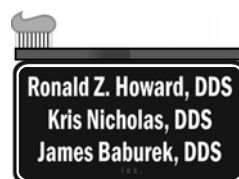

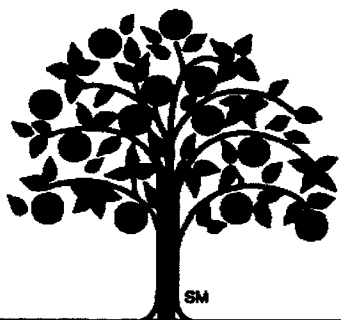
