

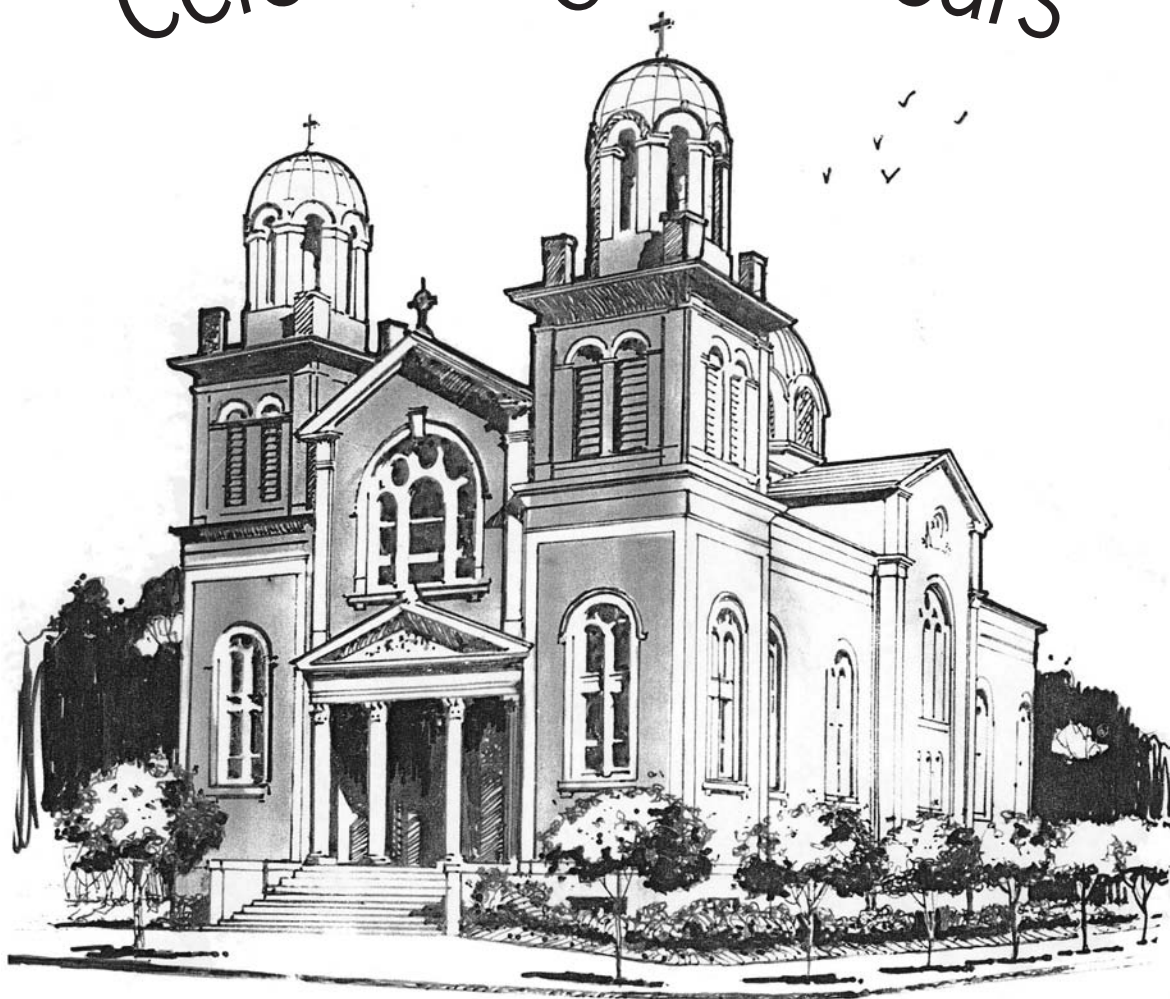

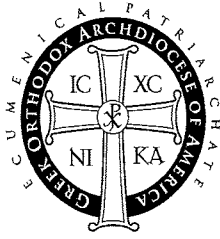

At our last meeting, we discussed another bus trip to The Greek Town Casino possibly in August. Please look for information as it becomes available.

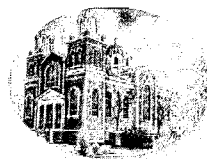

### **HOLY TRINITY HISTORY FROM THE TOLEDO BLADE**

#### **POLICE GUARDING GREEK PASTOR**

From the Toledo Blade Newspaper - November 8, 1923.

"The Rev A. Mandelaria, new pastor of the Greek Orthodox church, Superior and Walnut streets, was under police guard in the church sanctuary, Thursday morning prior to scheduled services at 9:30 with which a faction that opposed his election threatened to interfere. Detectives Carroll and Timiney were sent to the church at the new pastor's request.

The Rev. Mandelaria was elected pastor, Wednesday in a close election, succeeding the Rev Emmanuel Papastafanou, who was favored by a faction nearly as large as that which elevated the Rev Mandelaria to the position.

Police were told that the Minority faction had made threats against the other.

Despite the threats the Rev. Mandelaria announced that services would be held as scheduled.

A few of the opposing faction were on hand at the appointed time."

As the outdoor temperatures continue to rise over the next couple of months, nothing satisfies like a cool and refreshing dessert.
