

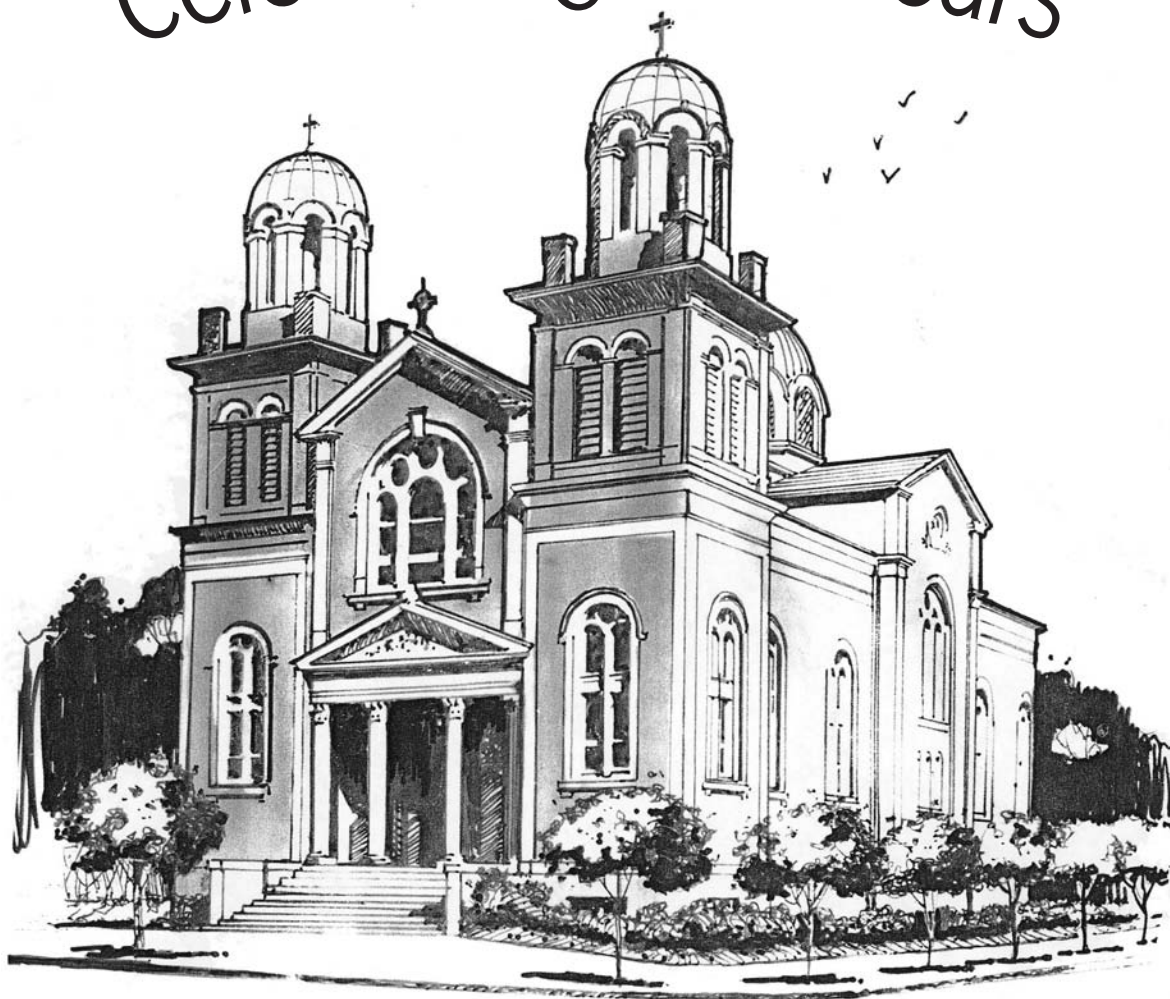

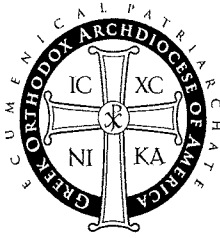

Dear Parish Family and Friends,
