

"Come and See"

Dear Parish Family and Friends,

One of the phrases my children use often with Presbytera and I is "come and see". They use this phrase when they are excited about something good they have done. They use this phrase with great joy as to announce that they have a wonderful surprise for us to witness. They use this phrase so Presbytera and I can participate in their joy. It is a call that is joyful and one that is not unique to my child. It is a call that our Church extends to us as well.

Our Lord wants more than anything for us to "come and see" in order to participate in His joy. The month of November is a time of the year that we are called, called to prepare ourselves to receive this great joy, the joy of the Nativity. The example that is put in front of us is that of St. Andrew. He was the one who heard this call from Christ to, "Come and see". He heard this call to see who Christ was and accepted it. We must remember that this call is for all of us. We are called to "come and see". An author once wrote, "The Church invites us during this season of Advent to identify ourselves with St. Andrew-since he was the first of the people of Israel to follow 'Him of whom Moses in the law, and also the prophets, wrote' (John 1:45)-and to share in the joy of his discovery."

This month we have all been called, called to "come and see" our Lord. We have been invited to joyfully discover the Christ child. We have been called to do this together as a Christ centered family. This is now our second Nativity season together. We have another chance to journey together to receive the Christ child. We have another opportunity to accept this invitation to grow closer to Christ and one another. I look forward to walking with you as we go to meet Him.

Philoptochos Sunday is the Feast Day of Saints Kosmas and Damian, the Patron Saints of National Philoptochos. On this day, we honor the memories of our Philoptochos members who have passed on. I would like to thank Dawn Anagnos and Joyce Anagnos for making the Artoklasia, Olympia Ntakos for the Koliva and Maria Tzanakis for arrangements for coffee hour refreshments table after Divine Liturgy.

"The new Saint Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church at Ground Zero will be much more than a rebuilt parish. It will be a National Shrine for our Holy Archdiocese and will be a place of pilgrimage for our nation and the whole world." It will be a National Shrine on hallowed ground. We will also use a portion of this year's funds to support the shelters following area and non-profit organizations; The Daughter's Project; The Bethany House; Life Connection of Northwest Ohio and The Family House. "GREECE UNCORKED" will be a great evening filled with fun, Greek food, beer, wine, and entertainment including silent auction and raffle. Our top chefs Maria and Andreas Petros and Jim Mitsopoulos will prepare the scrumptious food and will not disappoint. 





SUNDAY SCHOOL NEWS by Dr. Susan Karas Sieben

We have had 4 Sunday school classes so far with an average attendance of 22. Many new young boys have signed up for altar. HOPE and JOY and GOYA are starting, and our Fall Harvest Party will be Sunday October 25 from 6-8 pm.

Preschool /Kindergarten has the largest attendance. They are focusing on the Ten Commandments, Moses's life and the first two commandments - to Love God with all your heart; Worship only God.

1st and 2nd grade studies The Holy Cross and made cross bird feeders with paper towel rolls, peanut butter and bird seed. They also learned about the Holy Trinity and compared it to an apple. The skin is God, the inside flesh is Jesus and the seeds are the Holy Spirit. Lessons from the Archdiocesan book cover Love, God's love for us, our parent's love for us and how we are to love

others. October 26th is the feast day of St. Demetrios who is the Patron Saint of Thessaloniki. They are a busy class.

3rd and 4th grade are studying "Sharing God's World", learning about how happy we feel when we share, and the Story of Abraham's Blessing, and God's gift to Moses.

5th and 6th grade are perfecting the Lord's Prayer in Greek and English; learning our Church hymn in Greek and English; studying the Exaltation of the Holy Cross with activities from "My Little Orthodox Christian Books" from Saint Nicholas Monastery in North Fort Myers, Florida. As soon as we have more students we will hand out parts for the Christmas pageant which will be December 20th

Junior High has studied Philotema and watched a video on it and its meaning. They will also learn the Divine Liturgy in depth.




