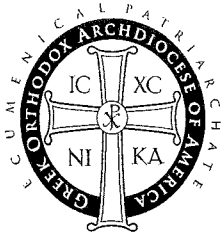


Dear Parish Family and Friends,

As I write this to you we are in the middle of November. The 24 hour Christmas music stations are about to begin. Macy's and the other big box stores are getting ready for "Black Friday". Everything is beginning to point to the fact that Christmas is right around the corner. We are being told to focus on Christmas. But for the life of me I can't seem to focus on Christmas! What are we to do? The Church in her wisdom helps us with this by giving us some feasts to help put things in perspective. One of them is the Entrance of the Virgin Mary into the Temple. This feast reminds us that she went to the Temple to become a Temple herself. We are called to do the same.

Fr. Thomas Hopko once wrote, "Jesus Christ, the Son, Word, and Image of God, is physically and spiritually formed in the body of Mary so that He might be formed in us as well. **Orthodox Christian Stewardship** is – a way of life, which acknowledges accountability, reverence, and responsibility before God. A primary goal of Stewardship is to promote spiritual growth and strengthen faith. Becoming a Steward begins when we believe in God, to whom we give our love, loyalty and trust and act on those beliefs. As Stewards, we affirm that every aspect of our lives comes as a gift from Him. Stewardship calls on the faithful to cheerfully offer back to God a portion of the gifts with which they have been blessed.

**Maintenance and Repair:** The first phase of repairs to our Cathedral dome, bell tower and associated roof structures began October 31<sup>st</sup>. We expect this phase to last about four weeks after which we will work with the contractor to identify the next step in the repair process and its associated cost.

We are actively soliciting proposals to repair the kitchen ceiling in the community center. The cost of this repair has not been finalized and will likely be paid for by withdrawing money from the Capital Improvement Fund.

Plans are underway to replace the Cathedral's 25+ year old air conditioning system. This work was deferred several years ago due to a shortage of funds. The cost of this repair is yet to be determined and will likely be paid for by withdrawing money from the Memorial Fund. This project will be an agenda item for the March 2017 Parish Assembly.

**Absentee Balloting** - At the Special Parish Assembly held on November 20, 2016 some members requested that absentee balloting be provided for Parish Council elections. I researched this issue and found that absentee balloting is only authorized by the Archdiocese Uniform Parish Regulations (UPR) if provided for in Parish Bylaws. Unfortunately, our Parish Bylaws do not provide for absentee balloting. Therefore, we have not met the UPR requirements of absentee balloting and are unable to honor this request.

**The Holiday Season** – The Feast of the Nativity of Jesus is one of the most joyful days of the Orthodox Church. It ranks next to the greatest holiday, the Resurrection of Jesus. The Feast of the Birth of Jesus is also known as the "Incarnation of Christ." This means that Jesus became a man and came into the world to save us. We also refer to this joyous feast as Christmas. Kathy and I wish all of you a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year!

**On A Personal Note:** Kathy and I plan to become "Snow Birds" in 2017 spending 4-6 months during the winter in a warmer climate. Being gone this amount of time does not allow me to be an effective member of parish council. Therefore, I will resign from parish council on December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2017.

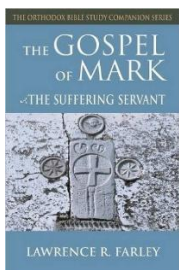

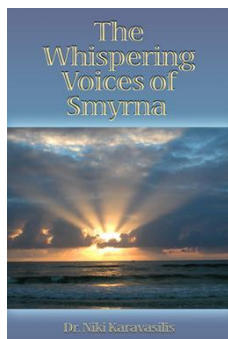

"The Whispering Voices of Smyrna" combines history and storytelling so that readers understand how the decision by government and military leaders of the victorious Allied powers affected the people of Smyrna. Through the eyes of the Samithakis family, one lives the cataclysmic events that determined the fate of Asia Minor following World War I. The Samithakis family lived a life of luxury among the different nationalities in Smyrna, until the Turks forced them to flee with other Greek, Armenian and European residents of Smyrna. In the course of their struggle to save themselves from the fire, the massacres, rapes, mutilations and plundering, they lost one another and became refugees, beggars and exiles. The reader also lives through the stages of destruction of a civilization centered on the once-thriving and beloved city of Smyrna.

## ADDITIONAL GREEK LANGUAGE OPPORTUNITY

A mini course entitled "Conversational Greek" will be offered beginning March 1st. This is a 10-12 week course focusing on conversational skills about everyday life activities such as "Greetings & Introductions", "At a restaurant", "Going shopping", etc. We will use phonetics for instruction, with no emphasis on grammar or spelling but will use grammatical clarifications as needed. No prior knowledge of Greek is required but is welcomed if previously acquired. The class will be taught by Basil Apostolou, former Greek School teacher and director. 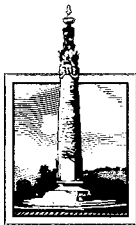

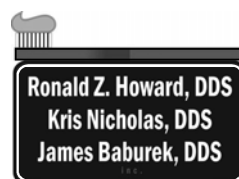
