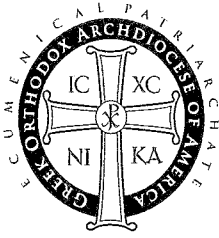

Dear Parish Family and Friends,



ADDITIONAL GREEK LANGUAGE OPPORTUNITY

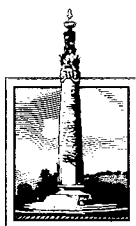

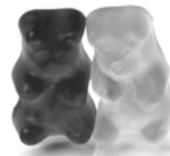

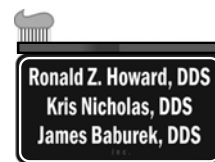
