PHILANTHROPY FOR GENERATIONS

Challenges/Charity/Initiatives

Three very important words for Philoptochos. In 2016, Maria Logos, National Philoptochos President, issued a challenge for the Chapters to provide 250,000 meals for the needy. The Chapters rose to the challenge and surpassed the number of meals and provided 750,000 meals. The Feeding the Children Everywhere organization honored Philoptochos with the Hungry Hero Award. Maria continued to challenge our chapters every two years. In 2018, the number was raised to 1,000,000 meals and 1,343,000 meals were provided. Our new challenge is to provide 1,500,000 meals by 2020. I am sure the Chapters will once again surpass that number. Our chapter has embraced the feeding the needy and has provided 1,475 meals so far. Our Metropolis fed 80,000 people. We are Philo-Strong!

The National Philoptochos, with the generosity of the Chapters, distributed \$106,710 to the Attica Fire Victims. These donations will help people to rebuild their homes and livelihoods. The Royal Tea Metropolis fundraiser was a huge success. The \$11,434.00 raised was divided equally between the Partners in Philanthropy Fund and the Emergency Fund. Charity and generosity continues! National Philoptochos disbursed \$563,084 to our ministries. This was made possible by the 400 chapters and 25,000 dedicated hardworking stewards.

The new educational initiatives are to inform and improve lives. The initiatives are:

- 1. Be safe, Be smart
- 2. Inclusion Ministries
- 3. Stop Bullying
- 4. Women's Health Committee
- 5. Alzheimer's Disease

Thank you to our parishioners for wearing Pink for Breast Cancer Awareness. Also, thank you to Kathy Chaka for setting up the Philoptochos Ministry Table and honoring Wear Pink for Breast Cancer Awareness with the lovely Parish Council Pink Table. Pink ribbons were distributed by Barbara Hartford and Ann Mulopulos. Volunteering, compassion, and sharing time and talent are important parts of Philoptochos.
