Dear Parish Family and Friends,

As I write this letter we are in the middle of the month of November. November is an important month for Presvytera and I because on November 1st we celebrated our 15th wedding anniversary. We celebrated all that God has given us. We celebrated what we have accomplished together. We remembered the wonderful times and the challenges that life brings. All of this made our celebration most meaningful. The Church is having us look to a celebration as well. That celebration is the Nativity of our Lord and Savior. A priest once wrote the following about this celebration, "Each year on November 15th, we begin the Orthodox Christian season of advent... For forty days, we prepare to celebrate the Nativity of Christ. We fast. We pray. We worship. When the Feast of the Nativity comes there is something to celebrate." Why is there something to celebrate? Because by prayer, fasting, worship, and remembering the less fortunate, we remember why we celebrate the Nativity.

I recently read the following, "For our society as a whole, Christmas has become "Getmas." Getmas is all about "getting" as much as possible, with no real restraint applied to the getting process. How many children evaluate a "good Christmas" based upon what they "get?" (Not all adults are exempt from such an evaluation I would imagine)." I share this because I thought it was a very clever way of describing how Christmas can became a time where we really celebrate nothing. If we are not careful it can became an excuse to get together, exchange a few gifts, have dinner and go home. The Church offers us a simple way of helping us stay focused. That happens with the present fast we are currently in. The Church asks us to fast, pray, and give alms. This exercise helps us to remember what is most important. Remember His words to Martha, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her." For us, abstaining from certain foods, adding more to your prayer life, and looking to help those in need will ensure that we remember the one thing needed; a relationship with Christ.

As we continue with our preparation to receive the Christ child on Christmas let us remember to put some effort into really receiving Him. Let us remember to put effort into really celebrating the day. I look forward to receiving Christ at the end of December with all of you, my parish family, having fasted more, prayed more, and offered kindness and help to others in the name of our Lord and Savior.

On Sunday, October 28th, 2018 after the Divine Liturgy, Greek School celebrated 'OXI DAY'. This holiday commemorates the Greek Premier Ioannis Metaxas, saying 'OXI'-NO to the Axis Forces demanding Greek Surrender in the early morning hours of October 28th, 1940. The proud and brave Greek Army pushed them deep into Italy dominated Albania. The entire world was shocked by the Greek bravery; little Greece stood up to the giants where other countries were surrendering one after another. Every year the 28th of October 1940 is celebrated as a National Holiday in Greece and abroad where Greeks live, to remind us of the 'OXI DAY'. This is the day the Greeks rejected the Italian ultimatum, fought for freedom and justice and won against all odds. Winston Churchill's words at the time were 'from now on we are not going to say that Greeks fight like heroes, but heroes fight like the Greeks'. Our main speakers for the day were students
