Dear Parish Family and Friends,

As I write this letter to you we are only days away from Christmas. Being days away from Christmas means we are only days away from Christmas dinner with our family and friends. These Christmas dinners remind me of a few things. First, how important family and friends really are to me. It reminds me that I truly need and cherish those relationships. Christmas dinner also reminds me that each of us in the family are a little bit different. It is those differences that make us unique but also better. These same ideas are true within our parish, the Church as a whole, and the Church of Sts. Basil the Great, Gregory the Theologian, and John Chrysostom whom we commemorate on the 30th of January.

Each of these saints were wonderfully talented and extremely holy men. Even though this is true they were each very different. St. Basil was a wonderful pastor, theologian, and monastic leader. St. Gregory the Theologian was not as great of a pastor as he was a theologian. St. John Chrysostom is not always viewed so much as a great theologian but instead a great preacher and pastor. He is known for his writing on the Christian life not on theological treatise. The thing they all had in common was they became Saints and powerful workers for the Church within the context of family and friends. The bottom line is they did not do it alone. Each of them had parents, friends, and siblings who are saints of the Church. Father Thomas Hopko wrote about these Three Holy men the following, "We see how no one can live in isolation, how even the greatest of the saints needed other saints to inspire and encourage them, to instruct and support them in their service." The same thing is as true today as it was for these saintly Bishops.

Each of us needs the other. Each of us cannot truly succeed spiritually without the other. In order for this parish to continue growing and in order for you and me to keep growing closer to Christ we need each other. Last year we witnessed many wonderful success in our community and with the reestablishment of the long range planning committee we are looking to see where it is we want to go in the future. All of this can only happen with each unique member being part of the process. Each of us, like the three Hierarchs, are different with our own gifts and talents. They did not grow and became saintly in isolation and neither can we. Together, with our unique gifts and talents, we will do God's will and together we will grow closer to Christ. Thank you for a wonderful 2018! I am very much looking forward to 2019.

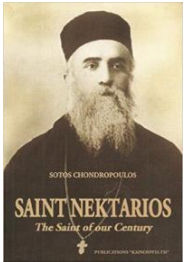
