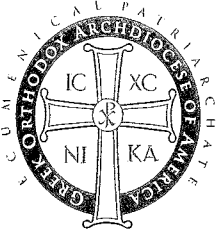

Applications are now available for the Ypsilanti Chapter #118 and Dodona Chapter #24 scholarships. All applicants must meet the following criteria. Applications are due April 19, 2019.

1. Applicant or applicant's parents must be a member in good standing of one or more of the following organizations:
 - a. Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Cathedral of Toledo, Ohio.
 - b. Order of AHEPA Ypsilanti Chapter NO. 118.
 - c. Daughters of Penelope Dodona Chapter #24
 - d. Maids of Athena
2. The criteria to be considered in awarding scholarships will be based on:
 - a. Scholastic achievement: The student must have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 out of a 4.0 GPA

- b. Leadership,
 - c. Extracurricular activities and,

3. Applicant must have been accepted by an accredited college or university.
