Dear Parish Family and Friends,

As I write this short note to you the sun is shining brightly. The world outside my window is beginning to come alive as spring starts to show itself. 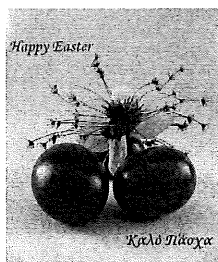

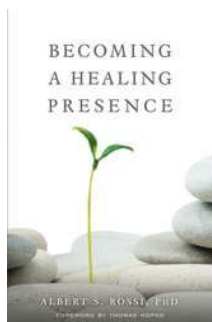

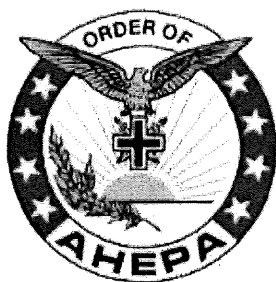


Michigan District Lent Retreat 2019

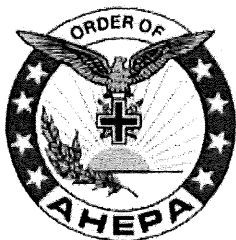

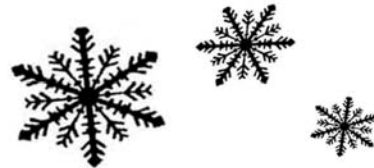
