Dear Parish Family and Friends,

Christ is Risen!

As I write this note to you we have just completed our journey to receive our Risen Lord. We walked through Great Week and witnessed all of the things that happened to our Lord for us and for our salvation. Now it is our time to respond to what we have received. Below I offer the Paschal sermon of St. Gregory the Theologian.

"Yesterday I was crucified with Him; today I am glorified with Him; yesterday I died with Him; to-day I am quickened with Him; yesterday I was buried with Him; to-day I rise with Him. But let us offer to Him who suffered and rose again for us—you will think perhaps that I am going to say gold, or silver, or woven work or transparent and costly stones, the mere passing material of earth, that remains here below, and is for the most part always possessed by bad men, slaves of the world and of the Prince of the world. Let us offer ourselves, the possession most precious to God, and most fitting; let us give back to the Image what is made after the Image. Let us recognize our Dignity; let us honor our Archetype; let us know the power of the Mystery, and for what Christ died. Let us become like Christ, since Christ became like us. Let us become God's for His sake, since He for ours became Man. He assumed the worse that He might give us the better; He became poor that we through His poverty might be rich; He took upon Him the form of a servant that we might receive back our liberty; He came down that we might be exalted; He was tempted that we might conquer; He was dishonored that He might glorify us; He died that He might save us; He ascended that He might draw to Himself us, who were lying low in the Fall of sin. Let us give all, offer all, to Him who gave Himself a Ransom and a Reconciliation for us. But one can give nothing like oneself, understanding the Mystery, and becoming for His sake all that He became for ours."

Community Cookbook by Phyllis Manton

Xristos Anesti!

Many blessings in this Paschal season. This truly is a time of celebration and renewal. After the fast we feast on the bounties of spring. Seasonal vegetables like artichokes with lamb and avgolemono are delectable, no drop of sauce is to be missed. Our cookbook has many recipes for lamb from roasts to stews. Peas and asparagus are also spring vegetables and they are so delicious with a little dill and onion and lemon juice and olive oil.

Spring wakes up all the plants and flowers from dormancy. One of the best kept secrets that Greeks have known for centuries is dandelion greens. Some people have seen them as the bane of their lawns while others welcome these yellow beauties. They provide pollen for bees to make honey and food for us. Recently dandelions have been in the news as healthy greens to eat, from roots to leaves. The roots can be cleaned, roasted and ground up and added to coffee or made as an infusion. My Pappou would drink the water from the boiled greens. He knew something. The properties in this lovely weed have many health benefits to strengthen the immune system. If you pick them make sure the source is from places that are not sprayed with pesticides. They can be bitter; the best time to pick them is before the flowers bloom.
