Christ is Risen!

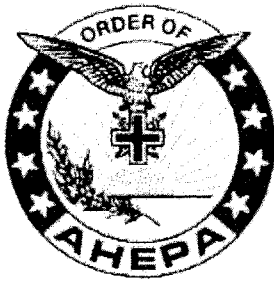

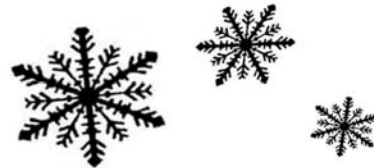
