The President's Message by Emmanuel T. Yakumithis

My dear fellow parishioners,

Thanks to everyone who have been signing up to participate in the Divine Liturgy. We have been at or near capacity for the past month and it's wonderful to see everyone in church. We have tried to work out all of the kinks of planning for social distancing, but there will always be small tweaks to make it work better. Please be patient as this process continues to change. Also, please remember to sign up rather than just showing up. This is for everyone's safety. If (God forbid) we had a parishioner test positive, we have a list of people who could have been exposed. If you just show up, and we are at capacity, we would have nowhere for you to sit and potentially set our progress back. As we follow the rules and work toward responsible reopening, we put ourselves ahead of the curve. If we start ignoring the rules or set them aside for one reason or another, we are hurting the progress to reopening.

On September 11-12, we will be hosting the "Taste of Greece" Drive Thru Event. Hours are 11 am to 7 pm, Friday and Saturday. We will be offering chicken and lamb dinners, gyros, pastichio, grapeleaves, spanakopita, and desserts. We will also offer beer and wines to go. Please consider helping offset the costs of our supplies by sponsoring a case of pastichio or several pounds of lamb or chicken. Think about what you would normally spend over the festival weekend and maybe donate that amount to help our bottom line.

Finally, with Covid-19 at its height this past spring, we were unable to have a Parish Assembly. We will be having our fall meeting on October 11, 2020 at 1 p.m., via Zoom. Due to the social distancing requirements of not having large gatherings, this seemed to be best option rather than trying to postpone again. You will receive instructions to log in either by computer or telephone. We will also include instructions for asking questions, and making motions. Please make every effort to be a part of the meeting. We will be discussing the proposed 2021 budget, building plans for the Cathedral (scaled back as requested by the assembly last fall), Parish Council nominations as well as those for Audit Committee and Elections Committee.

A Time for Every Purpose Under Heaven

Fall is here and summer is once again a memory...Many people are very apprehensive of what the Fall will bring, especially since everywhere you turn these days the news is filled with one depressing event after the next. But people by nature are optimistic, especially if prayer and faith are the center and light of their lives. Our beloved Holy Trinity has been that beacon of light for many throughout these past months since COVID began. We are so thankful each time we step into our Cathedral, even if right now it's only 60 parishioners at a time.

You may have been wondering how our 2020 Stewardship Campaign has been affected by all of this. I am very thankful to report that financially, Stewardship has been holding its own. Thanks to many of our Stewards who have pledged or fulfilled their pledge thus far, we are on track for hitting our Stewardship goal for the third year in a row. This would be amazing news in a regular campaign year, but as we know this year is unprecedented, so therefore this news is truly a blessing!

We prayed and worked so hard two years ago when we met our Stewardship goal of \$250,000 for the first time. Then, last year we forged ahead with the campaign slogan, *Watch Us Soar!*, and soar we did! We exceeded our Stewardship goal and ended the campaign with \$260,000! Below, you will see where our current 2020 Campaign stands...

- •This time "last year" we had 232 Stewards participating in Stewardship for a total of \$219,986.
- TODAY, we have 247 Stewards participating in Stewardship for a total of \$224,031
- •Currently, we have \$169,946 collected from the above pledges and donations.
