Our regular meetings are normally held September thru June during the first week of each month. Because of the COVID-19 restrictions we are forced to modify how we meet. Look for upcoming meeting notices in your email or regular mail.

We will be holding the Gyro to Go fund raiser on Friday, October 23 from 11:00 am to 1:30 pm. Spread the word to your co-workers, friends and family. Look for more details in the Holy Trinity weekly bulletin.

The pro football season has started. With that comes the Super Bowl and our annual Super Bowl Block fund raiser. The blocks will again be \$15. The numbers will change every quarter and the prizes will be \$125 for the first and third quarters, \$250 for the half and \$500 for the final. 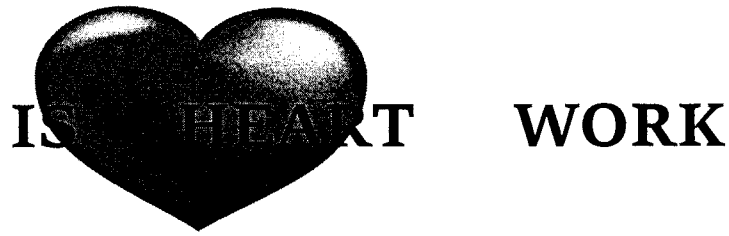

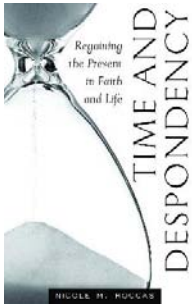
