The October monthly meeting was held via Zoom on Thursday, October 1, 2020. Our next meeting is scheduled for Thursday November 5,

On October 10, 2020, several Daughters met at the Toledo Botanical Garden to participate in the Walk to End Alzheimer's as members of the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Team. Although the main walk this year was held virtually due to Covid-19, it was fun to walk together safely and with proper social distancing to support this cause that affects so many families. The Holy Trinity Team raised a total of \$1,330 to support the fight against Alzheimer's. Thank you to Sister Alexia Hickman for organizing the Holy Trinity Team and also to parishioner Julia Pechlivanos, Director of the local Alzheimer's Association, who spoke to the church membership about Alzheimer's.

The Daughters District Workshop meeting was held via Zoom on Saturday, October 17, 2020. Fifteen District officers were in attendance with our local chapter represented by President JoAnn Cook. Topics of discussion included the status of our two District philanthropic projects, Autism Speaks and Water With Blessings (WWB). Autism Speaks is dedicated to "promoting solutions, across the spectrum and throughout the life span, for the needs of individuals with autism. It is the largest autism advocacy organization in the United States. The mission of WWB is "to provide clean water for God's thirsty children". It is an international organization based in Louisville, Kentucky.

The Daughters and the AHEPANs sponsored a drive-through carry-out luncheon fundraiser "Gyros to Go" from 11 am – 1:30 pm on Friday, October 23, 2020. On Sunday, October 25th, 2020 after the Divine Liturgy, Greek School celebrated "OXI DAY." This Holiday commemorates the Greek Premier Ioannis Metaxas saying "OXI" – "NO" -- to the Axis Forces demanding Greek surrender in the early morning hours of October 28th, 1940. The proud and brave Greek Army pushed them deep into Italy-dominated Albania. The entire world was amazed by the Greek bravery. Little Greece stood up to the giants while other countries were surrendering one after the other. Every year the 28th of October 1940 is celebrated as a National Holiday in Greece and abroad where Greeks live to remind us of the "OXI DAY." This is the day the Greeks rejected the Italian ultimatum, fought for freedom and justice, and won against all odds. Winston Churchill's words at the time were, "From now on we are not going to say that Greeks fight like heroes, but heroes fight like the Greeks." After the Doxology led by Fr. Larry Legakis, the American and Greek National Anthems were sung. After that we heard the OXI DAY speeches in Greek by Presv. Jenny Legakis and in English by Mrs. Alexia Hickman. They gave us beautiful and informative speeches. Many thanks and God Bless both of you. Then the Greek School students recited poems: Vasilia Legakis recited "Το Όχι το αθάνατο" ("The immortal OXI"), Electra Hickman recited "Η Ελλάδα Ποτε Δεν Πέθαινη" ("I Ellatha Pote then Petheni"), and Lukia Legakis recited "Η Ελληνική Σιμεία" ("I Elliniki Simeia"). Warmest congratulations to all of them, and we are so pleased the entire program is available on YouTube. Coffee hour was provided outside by Greek School, weather permitting. Many thanks to Joyce Anagnos for helping out with ZOOM for our classes and to George Anagnos for providing his computer with ZOOM. God bless you all and Happy Holidays.

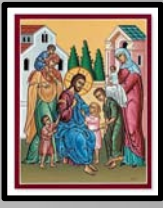

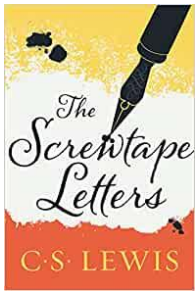

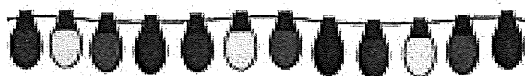
