President's Report by Emmanuel T. Yakumithis

My dear fellow parishioners,

We've finally made it to the end of this year. And what a different year it's been...

We had many hurdles and obstacles to overcome, but as a family, we made it! Each and every one of you had a role in our parish's success. Although we were unable to be together in a physical sense, we grew closer emotionally and spiritually. Whatever the request was, you all went above and beyond. Our stewardship commitments are being met and exceeded. Our building project is now under way. Our community involvement isn't in person, but donations of food items, hygienic items and money, are still rolling in.

We've grown weary of living in a virtual world, but we've done our best to get through it as positively as we can. In a time where other parishes are being pulled apart by the emotional and financial stress of our current situation, we are bonded and stable. I wish that Father Larry and I could take credit for this, but the reality is that no matter what we say or do, the bonds of this community are so strong that we are overcoming the obstacles of 2020 with humility and caring.

DID YOU KNOW: On Christmas Day, 2020, our beloved Cathedral's doors will have been open for 100 years? The first service was on Christmas Day, 1920 with a full house of faithful parishioners who came to celebrate a permanent home of worship. If you cannot attend the Christmas Day services, please log on and be a part of this milestone anniversary from home.

Renovation update: On November 8, 2020, the parish assembly voted to move forward with the updated renovation project. Once the demolition permit is approved, the ramp on the side of the Cathedral will be removed to begin construction. During this period, which will most likely last until late March or early April, anyone who is unable to maneuver the stairs will be accommodated at the Educational Building, with Father Larry offering Holy Communion at the conclusion of the Divine Liturgy. We know this is an inconvenience, but the long term benefits will outweigh the short term problems. I would like to thank Mary Ann Graham Topmoeller, of Blessed Memory for her bequest of \$75,000 to Holy Trinity which helped move this project forward, debt free.

Dome Update: I never cease to be amazed at the generosity of the Holy Trinity Family. In this issue of the Echo, we have included a letter from Maria Proestou. Maria grew up at Holy Trinity and was an active member throughout her life. Recently she contacted Father Larry to sponsor the repair of the Dome and Iconography. Maria's commitment to our beloved Cathedral is awe inspiring and our gratitude cannot be expressed completely in words. Also, my personal thanks to Maria and also to her parents, Andreas and

Tasoulla Proestou for instilling the values of the importance of church, family, and giving.

Finally, as we wind down 2020 and look to the future, I would like to once again thank you all for your input, feedback and support. To say the least, we had many challenges this year, but calls, texts and email that I received helped guide me down a path to serve all of you as best I could. My best to each of you for a very blessed Christmas and a healthy and prosperous New Year
