Dear Parish Family and Friends,

Around this time last year I offered a sermon about the importance of showing up. I offered a few sayings that relate to the importance of success and showing up. Sayings like, "The first secret to success is showing up", "The single biggest thing you can do for your career is showing up.", "you must be present to win", and one last one is "step one is showing up". Now, I gave this sermon right before the pandemic really got into full swing. I offered this just before we were asked to not show up. At this point in time, we are being asked to show up carefully and in a limited way. Many of us are still weary about being "present". The question is how do we grow in our faith, closer to Christ, and one another if we are still not able to be physically present?

The thing we have to remember about our Lord is that He came and sanctified everything. Remember Jesus was born, He grew and was circumcised, He was presented in the temple as a child, and finally He was Baptized. All of this shows us that He totally identifies with us. I think it also means He can sanctify and make things that are normal moments into potentially holy ones. Everyday things that seem normal can bring us closer to God. Things that have become "new normal" like watching services on YouTube at home can also bring us closer to God. For that to happen we need to be truly present and really show up.

In the Feast of the Presentation, we have two people who were truly present and received blessings from God. Saint Simeon and Saint Anna. Simeon and Anna were able to meet the Lord because they were present. Not because they were lucky to be in the temple when Jesus was there but because they were present all the time. Each time they went to the temple they were present both physically and with their heart and mind. They were open to the Lord and they were patient. Simeon came back year after year waiting to see the Messiah. His being present and open to Christ gave him the blessing to see the Lord.

My friends and my family in Christ, in order to receive the blessings that Christ has for us and to be a blessing to others we need to be present. For now, it is not about being here physically but it is about being open to seeing where God is. Whether you are at home worshiping or here, be present and open. Open to how God is calling you to grow closer to Him and where you can help be a blessing to others.

In an effort to keep everyone up to date we will try and offer an update each Friday on the renovation project. Below please find last week's updates as well as this weeks.

- 12/21/2020 Removal of the existing ramp was completed.
- 12/29/2020 Excavation for the foundations was completed
- 1/5/2021 Reinforcing steel assembled for the footers  
Electrician arrived to relocate the electrical service to the Cathedral  
Bricklayers erecting the main walls of the addition
- 1/8/2021 Electrician has relocated the new main meter and entry conduits into the basement. Electrician will have to wait for Edison to relocate the new power lines to the new meter.
- 1/13/2021 Contractor back filling the footers and foundation areas. Block walls are up to the level of the new entry into the Cathedral. Plumber arrived to determine where the water and sewer lines will enter the basement of the Cathedral.
- 1/15/2021 Plumber has installed all of the piping for the new restrooms and into the Cathedral Basement.
- 1/20/2021 Contractor has completed back filling the area under the new addition.  
Contractor has prepared the addition for the pouring of the concrete floors.
