Dear Parish Family and Friends,

My dear fellow parishioners,

I am pleased to inform you that we are slowly moving out of the strict pandemic requirements that we've lived with for over a year now. The Governor has intimated a "full opening" by summer but has also said that due to variants in the COVID strains, he makes no promises. That said, we are working on plans for the Greek American Festival, but are also keeping alternate plans in play for any changes that could arise.

Finally, as we approach Holy Week and Great Pascha, please remember to sign up in advance for the services. As of now, we are still only permitted 60 parishioners in the Cathedral. We have to keep in mind that those who did sign up, shouldn't be penalized and not have a seat because people are showing up. If you are not on the list and you show up, you will be asked to watch from the Educational Building. It is easy to sign up: you can do it online, or by phone.
