#### President's Report by Emmanuel T. Yakumithis

My dear fellow parishioners,

On October 17, 2021 we held our Parish Assembly meeting and were honored to have His Eminence, Metropolitan Nicholas in attendance. He mentioned to those in attendance how good it was to see how respectful the tone of the meeting was and how we seem to be united. This is a testament to all of you. There were some questions that arose during the meeting but the conversations were not antagonistic, rather truly sincere.

The primary topic of interest was our proposed 2022 budget. The operating budget for 2021 was \$645,000 but we felt that we needed to trim wherever we could and past a more conservative budget of \$587,000, unanimously. Our parish council has tried to make sure that we are good stewards of your money. Between our lean budget and our good return on investments, we are entering the new year in a stable financial position.

On December 5, 2021 Parish Council elections will be held. You will be completing two ballots this year: the first if for the council members whose terms expired in 2020 (filling the remainder of the term through December 2023) and a separate ballot for council members whose terms expire at the end of 2021. If you were not in attendance for the Parish Assembly meeting and want to be considered, please contact the office. A letter will also be sent to the parish with instructions regarding eligibility.

As we move toward Thanksgiving, please keep in mind those less fortunate and perhaps donate a little extra to the food pantry, which has grown from a few small boxes of canned goods and cereal to an entire room of canned and dry foods, and personal hygiene products. There is always a need for more. We have people reach out regularly for any assistance that we can give.

Finally, in addition to being thankful for my family who continue to support my efforts, I am thankful to each and every one of you. YOU make this parish what it is and I thank you all for being a part of our community.
