Dear Parish Family and Friends,

One of things I love to see is when my kids work well together. It is a joy to see them when they are not arguing but agreeing on a way forward. It is pleasant because there is no fighting but instead, they themselves work together joyfully. It reminds me of what the Lord said about that as well, "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!" The interesting thing is that dwelling in unity with each other is made easier when we remember to dwell in unity with God.

The Church has a word which is used to describe this relationship and that word is Synergy. Synergy means to be a co-worker or to cooperate. In terms of the Church it means to be a co-worker or to cooperate with God's will. We see this very much in a feast we celebrate this month.

The Feast I am thinking about is that of The Presentation of our Lord into the Temple. In Greek the feast is called $\Upsilon \pi \alpha \pi \alpha \nu \tau \dot{\eta}$. The feast remembers when the Lord was brought to the temple and held in the arms of Saint Symeon. It is a great example of synergy and it begins with Mary saying yes to God and becoming the mother of our Lord. It continues when she offers back to God, in the Temple, that very gift she and the world was given.

We too are called to something very similar. We are called to a life where we work with God to attain His goals for us. This means we must be aware of Him in our lives. It means we must see Him in each other. It means we must be grateful for all the ways He blesses us. Lastly, we then offer back to Him the gifts He has given to us.

My family in Christ, I thank you for the many ways you work for our Church. I pray that as we continue in the year 2022 we remember to first look to God to guide us. I pray that we work with Him in order to accomplish the goals He sets for us.



Warm Hands to Warm Hearts

Thank You, Thank You, Thank You. We are in the process of sewing together 22 Lap Blankets, and 4 Blankets have already been donated. That is 550 rectangle pieces for just this group of 22 Blankets. Thank you to everyone who has made any and donated towards this project. They are beautiful. It will take a while for them to be sewn together before we have Father Larry Bless them.

Our meeting time has changed to 1:00 p.m. Same place, the Church Hall, same date, Tuesday, February 22, 2022 (02-22-2022. Look at all those 2's). Bring with you a size 8 or 9 pair of Knitting needles or size K or 6.50 Crochet hook. Yarn and directions will be provided. Our Classes on Knitting and Crocheting for those who want to learn how to Knit & Crochet and those that know how to Knit & Crochet. Come no matter whether you know how to or are advanced yarners. We will have a good time together helping one another.

Continue knitting and crocheting 7x9 inch rectangles.

The pieces are all different colors, different stitches and different kinds of yarn, but go together so good. Some are all one color, some are mixed up colors, some variable colors and all are so pretty.

When we get some more pieces in we will be able to put them together, as a Lap Blanket or scarf. It takes 25 pieces to make a Lap Blanket. If you just want to knit a blanket, a Baby Blanket size is 35x36", a Lap Blanket is 35x45". We welcome whatever you can do. I am sure Father Larry is waiting for some finished pieces to give away. I am sure they will be appreciated this winter.

There are a few skeins of yarn at the church (in the old Superior office) and if you don't knit or crochet and would like to donate some yarn, we would be happy to have them. Just drop them off at Church. If you have some pieces finished and can't get them to the church, give us a call and we will make arrangement to get them. This should keep us busy all winter. If you weren't able to be in Church on Vasilopita Sunday, the following is an important message that I presented to our community...

"Hello Everyone and a Happy New Year to all of you and your families! I'm very excited to be here today wearing my Stewardship hat to give you all some very good news, *unprecedented news actually...* As you know, Father Larry and I spent most of 2021 between his sermons, my articles, and email blasts asking everyone in the Parish to consider God's many blessings that he has bestowed upon your family, and then, give to Holy Trinity to the best of your ability.

Well for the fourth year in a row, we've done just that! Our Stewardship goal for the 2021 campaign was \$250,000 and we achieved it!!! Sooo exciting! Well something you may not have heard is that the Parish Council decided to raise the goal for this year's 2022 Stewardship Campaign to \$275,000.

That is why we are beyond excited to tell you that Holy Trinity ended its 2021 Stewardship Campaign at \$284,132 which has surpassed next year's "new goal" already by over \$9,000.

What's really important for everyone to understand is that last year in 2021, expenses for the Church were \$497,550.

That means that for the first time ever, at 57.11%, your Stewardship covered over half the budget of Holy Trinity!!!!

The more that Stewardship covers our expenses, the more we can use our festival money and memorial donations to extend our outreach and ministries. In addition, this will allow us to make improvements on this beautiful century old Cathedral and keep it alive and thriving for generations to come.

So, THANK YOU to everyone for opening your hearts to our Stewardship program and above all to God from whom all these blessings flow. ...and to top it ALL off, it cannot go without saying, we achieved all of this during a Global Pandemic!"
