Dear Parish Family and Friends,

One of the things I have noticed while raising our children is that things go really well when Presbytera and I are in full agreement with regards to the kids. I know it seems like a simple thing, but being in full agreement with anyone is not always easy. I think all of us have seen this in our own lives, when people gather and agree on something things tend to go smoothly. We see this often in the scriptures as well. The scriptures tend to use the phrase "one accord" to describe this unity.

We read this phrase in the book of Acts at the Ascension and Pentecost. After the Lord ascended, we read, "These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers." Again, we read at Pentecost, "When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place." The Greek word used here is "homothumadon" which can also refer to a group acting as one. It is in this oneness that our Lord manifested the Holy Spirit. It is in this oneness that the Church grew and spread to all the known lands. It is this oneness that must continue to move the Church and our parish forward as well.

My family in Christ, as a community there are many things we would like to do. We have the festival coming up and preparations are underway. There are things we would like to see with regards to our ministries. All of these things are possible if we do them "with one accord". The history of the Church and the history of our parish has proven when we act as one the Lord acts with us. Let us continue to move forward as a community with oneness.



#### PHILANTHROPY FOR GENERATIONS

This past year has been wonderful for Philoptochos to be able to celebrate fully in person with all of the members of Holy Trinity. It was clear by the smiles and participation, our parish was ready to be together and celebrate. The first traditional Vasilopita held in two years was a little different than in past years and still managed to be just as meaningful.

Philoptochos, partnered with the Daughters, have continued to stock the food pantry. Now that the pantry is partnered with Seagate Foodbank, much needed fresh meats and vegetables are available to our neighbors in need. The food pantry was able to provide 40 boxes stocked with items to the Madonna Homes, as well as help anyone that stops by the church.

Advocating Opportunity came to us a month ago with a survivor of Human Trafficking that was in need. The food pantry and donations were able to feed and clothe the young lady, and the Philoptochos purchased a weighted blanket to help ease her anxiety. Recently, Philoptochos welcomed members of Advocating Opportunity to speak to our members and opened up the informational meeting to the church assembly. Shortly after their visit, the intake advocate contacted Father Larry with an urgent need for a teenage human trafficking survivor that had no clothing or belongings. Once again, Philoptochos raced into action by supplying

clothing, purses and personal items for the young woman.

The Philoptochos group is open to all members of the church. If you cannot make meetings, but are willing to help on an urgent call to arms, please consider joining. Maria Kopan organizes membership, or you can ask any Philoptochos member how to join.

The Metropolis Philoptochos is honoring the men who have supported Philoptochos in the spring "No Show" Fund Raising Event. This event will raise monies to directly benefit the Metropolis Philoptochos ministries. The Philoptochos of Holy Trinity has chosen to honor two very deserving men.

George Mulopulos had been a constant fixture in Philoptochos and the events for as long as many of us can remember. There was no task he would not take on. Mr. Mulopulos would help in Philoptochos workshops, during Makarias, he would help paint if needed, sort items for the rummage sale, and most importantly, make coffee for the meetings. Mr. Mulopulos is greatly missed and will be honored in memoriam through the Metropolis Philoptochos.
