Everyone is welcome to come whether you can knit or crochet or are not able to. There are many jobs to do so you can help. If you want to learn to knit or crochet, bring with you a **size 8 or 9** pair of Knitting needles or **size K or 6.50** Crochet hook. Yarn and directions will be provided.

Continue knitting and crocheting 7x9 inch rectangles.

The pieces are all different colors, different stitches and different kinds of yarn, but go so good together. Some are all one color, some are mixed up colors, some variable colors and all are so pretty.

It takes 25 pieces to make a Lap Blanket. If you just want to knit a blanket, a Baby Blanket size is 35x36", a Lap Blanket is 35x45". We welcome whatever you can do. I am sure they will be appreciated.

We are still in need of yarn any color, any kind and any amount. There are a few skeins of yarn at the church, and if you don't knit or crochet and would like to donate some yarn, we would be happy to have them. Just drop them off at Church. If you have some pieces finished and can't get them to the church, give us a call and we will make arrangement to get them. This should keep us busy all fall & winter. If you were unable to attend the October General Assembly meeting, the following is what I presented to those in attendance...

Recently, Metropolitan Nicholas came to our Church to visit us the weekend of the festival, and we engaged in a conversation about our Stewardship program. I was very proud of our community as I told him that we have continually met and surpassed our Stewardship goals consistently for the last five years. He asked what we bring in every year and when I told him, he said, "Where do you get the rest of your money to meet your yearly budget?" He of course knew the answer... the festival. He then made a comment that I want to share with you that he later used in his sermon that day. He said, when referring to using the festival as a main money source, "Do you invite guests to your home and serve them food, and then charge them for it in order to pay your monthly bills?" Holy Trinity is our home...

I. Goal for the 2022 Stewardship Campaign:
\$275,000

**II. Status of Current 2022 Holy Trinity Cathedral Stewardship Campaign
As October 21, 2022...**

242 Stewards have filled out pledge cards and paid Stewardship totaling \$210,542

27 Stewards giving, but have not filled out pledge cards totaling \$10,628

*269 Total Stewards Pledging and Giving
Monies collected to date \$221,170

**III. This same time last year - As of approx.
October, 2021...**

234 Stewards had filled out pledge cards and paid Stewardship totaling \$200,464 53 Stewards giving, but had not filled out pledge cards totaling \$17,949

*287 Total Stewards Pledging and Giving
Monies collected to date \$218,412

It is important to note: *This time last year, we had more Stewards pledging less money. This year, we are \$2,758 in monies collected ahead of last year with less Stewards. Though we are excited to be ahead of last year, we don't want to be losing Stewards even though our existing Stewards are stepping up and doing their part.*

IV. Last year, after four previous successful campaigns of hitting our goal of \$250,000, we surpassed our first-time new goal of \$275,000 and hit an amazing total of \$282,000. **God willing, it is realistic to assume if all**

things continue as they are going, that we will achieve our goal of \$275,000 again, and we are on track to surpass it once again.

V. 2023 Stewardship Campaign Kick-Off and Stewardship Sunday Brunch

On **Sunday, November 20th**, we will once again be celebrating Stewardship Sunday with the blessing of the pledges by Father Larry in Church to thank God for His many blessings. We would also like to cordially invite **EVERYONE** to a "complimentary lunch" provided by Parish Council and your Stewardship Committee after Church in the Social Hall. **Please look for the Online Kick-Off of the 2023 Campaign.** We would love to see everyone make their 2023 pledge online, but for those who find this difficult we will be sure to send you your pledge card in the mail. What's most important is that everyone has access to making their 2023 Stewardship pledge in the way they find easiest. **We look forward to seeing everyone on November 20th fill the Church as we kick-off our 2023 Holy Trinity Stewardship Campaign!**

Closing Remarks...

After 8 years of being your Stewardship Chairman, I'd like to think that one thing that I brought to the table in this position is transparency. I do not believe when talking about money and finances for our Cathedral that it is a good idea to give people a false sense of security. I feel like if everyone understands our financial situation, then we will all do everything in our power to do what is best for our beloved Holy Trinity. At the same time, I also feel it is very important to praise people when good work is being done. To that end, I am continually thankful that for the last five years our community continues to hit its Stewardship goals and surpass them. We are never better as a community than when we are working together towards a common goal. The question is always, "Are we doing enough?" You will see today as we present the new budget and you hear the important part that our Stewardship program plays in our Strategic Plan for Holy Trinity moving forward, that of course the answer will always be, we need to do more. Until Stewardship becomes the main source of funding for this Cathedral and not the festival, we need to continually strive towards drawing in new Stewards and making them feel welcome in our ministries. Then and only then will ALL Stewards take on the responsibility for financially supporting Holy Trinity and sustaining it for future generations.

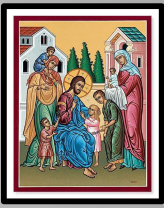
