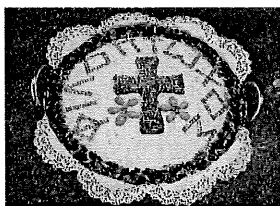

***Greek School News by Dawn Anagnos, Director, Instructor***

On Sunday, October 30, 2022 after the Divine Liturgy, Greek School celebrated "OXI DAY." This holiday commemorates the Greek Premier Ioannis

Metaxas saying, "OXI!"-"NO!" to the Axis Forces demanding Greek surrender in the early morning hours of October 28, 1940. The proud and brave Greek Army pushed them deep into Italy-dominated Albania. The entire world was amazed by the Greek bravery. Little Greece stood up to the giants while other countries were surrendering one after the other. Every year the 28<sup>th</sup> of October 1940 is celebrated as a National Holiday in Greece and the Greek Diaspora to remind us of "OXI Day." This is the day the Greeks rejected the Italian ultimatum, fought for freedom and justice, and won against all odds. Winston Churchill's words at the time were, "From now on we are not going to say that Greeks fight like heroes, but that heroes fight like the Greeks."

The program began with the Altar Boys processing with the Holy Cross, the Exapteriga and the Greek, Cypriot, and American flags. Thank you to altar boys Andrew Ellis, Daniel Ellis, Jeramiah Iglesias, Gus Jackson, Costa Matthews, Liam McCullough, Preston Schwartz for the procession. After the Doxology and the American and Greek National Anthems beautifully sung by the Choir, we heard a short speech by Jessica Williams for the Greek National Flag, which is celebrated on October 27<sup>th</sup>, followed by the poem "Η Ελληνική Σημαία" ("I Elliniki Simea") recited by Lukia Legakis and Jessica Williams. Next was the beautiful and moving OXI DAY speech in Greek by Maria McMurray, followed by Alexander McMurray reciting "Η Ελλάδα Ποτέ Δεν Πεθαίνει" ("I Ellatha Pote then Petheni"). Presv. Jenny Legakis then gave the speech in English, followed by Vasilia Legakis reciting "Το Όχι το αθάνατο" ("The immortal OXI").

Warmest congratulations to all of them and to Fr. Larry Legakis for his leadership of the program. Thank you to Gene Haberman for making the entire program available on YouTube and Facebook, to Tom Photos and Nathaniel Harger for organizing the Altar Boys, to Maria Tzanakis for taking photos for the Echo, and to the Choir for their beautiful singing voices. Many thanks to Joyce Anagnos for helping out with ZOOM for our classes and to George Anagnos for providing his computer knowledge.

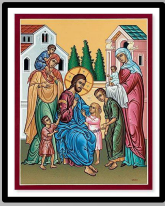

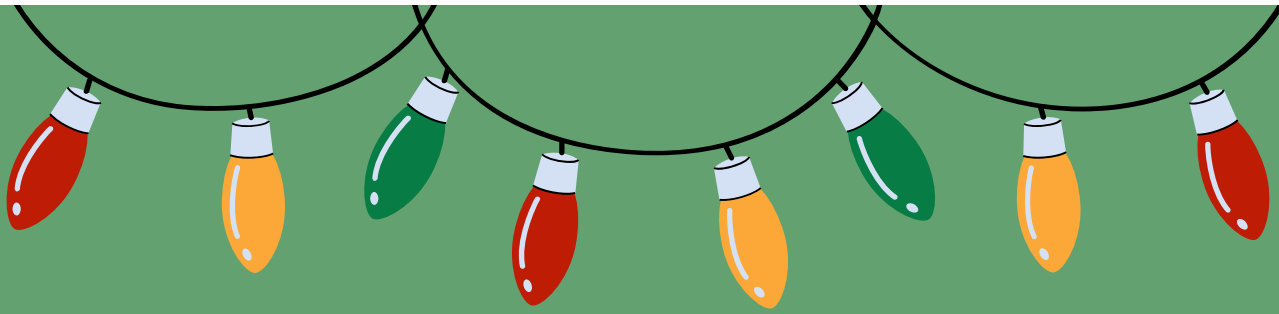

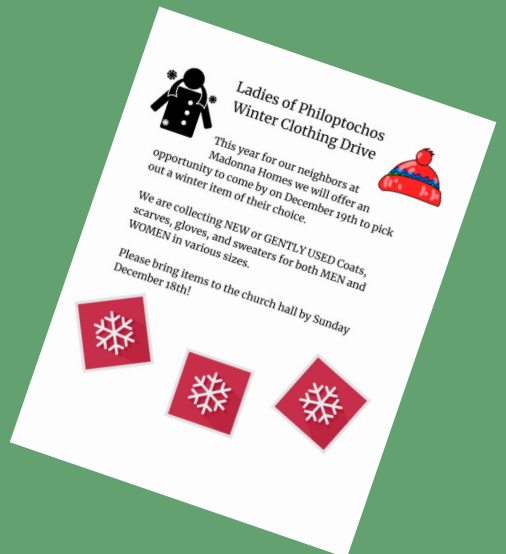
