As we enter our 4th year, we would like to remind you of our worthwhile ministry and invite you to join us. All warm hands and hearts are welcome to participate. We Need You!

WHO: Anyone with time on their HANDS and love in their HEARTS can join us: men, women, young, and old. We have a job for you. No need to know how to knit or crochet.

WHAT: We knit or crochet **7 x 9 inch rectangles** in any stitch, style, or pattern. The more interesting the better. We arrange the rectangles to design each blanket. Twenty-five pieces are sewn together. Finished blankets are folded and tied with a ribbon and gift tag.

WHEN: WHWH meets the last Tuesday of each month from 1:00 to 3:00 unless otherwise indicated.

WHERE: WHWH meets in the Ahepa Room in the Veronie Community Center.

WHY: Our mission is to help those in need in our community to keep warm by providing them with a lap blanket made with love. It's also fun and relaxing to knit or crochet the rectangles. Plus, creating something beautiful together makes us feel good. We have fun!

HOW: How can I help if I don't knit or crochet, you ask?

1. You can donate yarn to keep our supply stocked.
2. You can join us to sort rectangles by color and/or arrange them to create a beautiful design.
