Dear Parish Family and Friends,

I remember years ago when I was 8 years old I had an experience that I have never forgotten. I was at summer camp and not enjoying it at all. At that age I did not like to be away from home. I was constantly thinking about and asking to go home. One night we were having one of our dances. I was, of course, sitting on a couch pouting. All of a sudden one of the young counselors came over and took me by the hand and asked me to dance. I was a bit apprehensive but she talked to me and then I went with her. That event really changed my time at camp. I do not remember her name and if I saw her today, I would not remember her, but I remember what she did for me and how it changed my experience. It reminds me that sometimes we have to bring or, are ourselves, brought to Christ. Sometimes it is up to us to be those who invite other people to meet or to be reacquainted with our Lord.

On February 2nd we celebrate the feast of the Presentation of our Lord into the Temple. In Greek the feast is called $\Upsilon\pi\alpha\pi\alpha\nu\tau\dot{\eta}$. The feast commemorates the time our Lord was brought to the temple and held in the arms of Saint Symeon. Mary and Joseph did this to fulfill the Law and dedicate their son. Saint Symeon takes Jesus in his arms and says, "Lord, now let your servant depart in peace, according to your word; for my eyes have seen your salvation which you have prepared in the presence of all peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel." We continue this tradition of bringing all of our children to church in order to dedicate them to the Lord. We bring them so they can begin a relationship with our Lord.

This month I am being reminded that there are times when we not only bring our children but maybe a friend we have not seen in a while. We are to bring a friend, a family member, or even someone who is interested to see and meet Christ. Maybe they are struggling and they are in need of an invitation that could, through Christ, change their lives.

My family in Christ, as we continue in another year of ministry let us remember to be present and meet the Lord. Let us remember to be those who are open to bringing others so they can receive the same love and light that we do.
