Dear Parish Family and Friends,

Recently I came across this wonderful story that I wanted to share with all of you. "A young and well-intentioned woodcutter got a job with a good salary and decent work conditions. And so, the woodcutter was determined to do his best for the boss. His boss gave him an axe and on his first day, the woodcutter cut down 15 trees. The boss was pleased and said: 'Well done, good work!' Highly motivated, the woodcutter tried harder the next day, but could only cut 13. The third day he tried even harder, but only 11 trees were chopped down. Day after day, he tried harder, but he cut down fewer trees. 'I must be losing my strength,' the woodcutter thought. He apologized to the boss, claiming he could not understand why. The boss asked 'When was the last time you sharpened your axe? 'Sharpen? I had no time to sharpen my axe. I have been too busy cutting down trees,' said the woodcutter. He sharpened his axe and immediately was back to 15 trees a day. Since then, he begins the day by sharpening his axe."

As difficult as it is to say goodbye to Summer, there is something exciting about the beginning of Fall. Our community worked very hard this Summer to prepare for and execute one of our most successful Festivals to date! As I walked around the Festival, all I could see was a *labor of love*, and ALL of it was for our beloved Holy Trinity. Now, as students are back in Sunday school and our ministries are back in full swing under the enthusiastic guidance of our new ministry coordinator, Zach Heller, we are about to begin an exciting new chapter in the history of Holy Trinity.

On Sunday, October 22nd, I strongly encourage everyone to attend our Parish General Assembly. While there, we will outline the work that is in progress on our Priority Projects. With the approval and blessing of the Metropolitan, we will begin by presenting a timeline for completion of the Renovation of the Iconography in our Cathedral. Planning has also begun on another of our Priority Projects, the Renovation of the Kitchen and Veronie Community Hall Repurposing. Meetings have taken place with key individuals who have spent countless hours working in our kitchen. Together, they have compiled a list of *Wants and Needs* that are being given to a professional kitchen architect to create some preliminary plans for us to review.

In addition to these major Priority Projects, we have begun work on creating Holy Trinity's Archival room. This is a project that has been talked about since our 100th Anniversary and the creation of our 100th Anniversary album. It was at that time that we realized we needed a way to document, and store properly, the history of Holy Trinity. Chris Zervos has taken the lead on collecting and digitally recording and organizing this history. Please contact Chris if you have anything that would add to creating this Archival room.

As you can see, the coming year will be filled with many changes. I read a quote the other day that said, "Change is slow and gradual. It requires hard work, a bit of luck, a fair amount of self-sacrifice, and a lot of patience." We have waited a long time

to begin these Priority Projects, and it is my hope and prayer that with God's blessings, we will preserve Holy Trinity for future generations to come.

Now, let us remind you of what we do and how you can join in the fun.

WHAT: We knit or crochet 7 x 9 inch rectangles in any stitch, style, or pattern. The more interesting the better. We arrange the rectangles to design each blanket. Twenty-five pieces are sewn together. Finished blankets are folded and tied with a ribbon and gift tag.

WHEN: WHWH meets the last Tuesday of each month from 1:00 to 3:00 unless otherwise indicated.

WHERE: WHWH meets in the Ahepa Room in the Veronie Community Hall.

WHY: Our mission is to help those in need in our community to keep warm by providing them with a lap blanket made with love. It's also fun and relaxing to knit or crochet the rectangles. Plus, creating something beautiful together makes us feel good. We have fun!

HOW: How can I help if I don't knit or crochet, you ask?
