### *Greek School News by Dawn Anagnos, Director*

Greek School continues to be very active during The 2024-2025 school year. Sixteen youth and adult students enrolled in Greek School from around the country, and scheduled lessons are held via Zoom on Tuesdays (Adult Beginners), Wednesdays (Adult Intermediate and Advanced), and Saturdays (Youth).

On a rolling basis we receive inquiries from interested learners who discover the Greek School page of the church website, through social media, Greek Festival outreach word-of-mouth. To date, Greek School proudly presented one of its three annual programs to the community.

On Sunday, October 27, 2024 after the Divine Liturgy, Greek School celebrated "OXI DAY." This holiday commemorates the Greek Premier Ioannis Metaxas saying, "OXI!" ("NO!") to the Axis Forces demanding Greek surrender in the early morning hours

of October 28, 1940, and the recognized bravery of the Greeks during World War II. Winston Churchill's words at the time were, "From now on we are not going to say that Greeks fight like heroes, but that heroes fight like the Greeks."

The program began with the Altar Boys processing With the Greek, Cypriot, and American flags: Charis Besios, Abram Jackson, Gus Jackson, Caede Karavas, Prestor Schwartz, and Athanasios Tsipis. After the Doxology and the American and Greek National Anthems beautifully sung by the Choir and Chanters, we heard a speech by Paul Belazis for the Greek National Flag, which is celebrated on October 27<sup>th</sup>, followed by the poem "Η Ελληνική Σημαία." Next was the beautiful and Moving OXI! DAY speech in Greek by Stephanie Georgakopoulos, followed by the speech in English by Melody Tsapranis. Then Stephanie Birtsas-Schuppenies recited the song/poem "Η Ελλάδα ποτέ δεν πεθαίνει." The program concluded with Don Isenath reciting the poem, "Ζήτω το Όχι!"

Thank you and warmest congratulations to all participants and to Fr. Larry Legakis for his leadership of the program. Thank you to Gene Haberman for making the program available on YouTube and Facebook, to Tom Photos for organizing the Altar Boys, to Zachary Heller for his ministry coordination, to Angela Koustoumbardis who took pictures, to the Choir and Chanters for their beautiful singing voices, and to Kathy Chaka and Parish

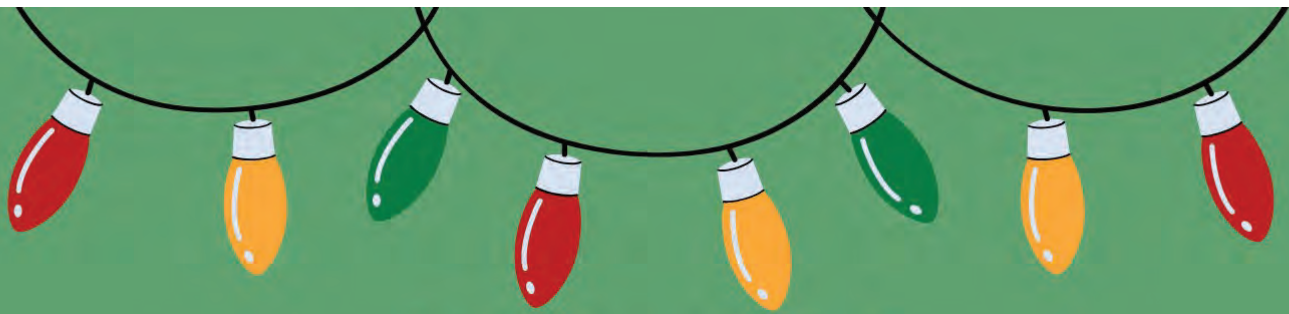

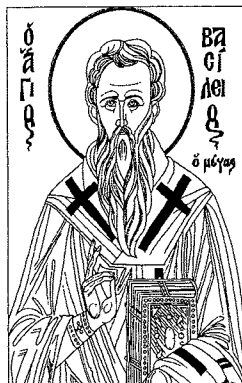
